WHAT IS THE PA?

- The PA is an independent registered charity with an elected committee who sign up to be trustees (usually for a two-year minimum term)
- Anyone with a child at The Blue School is automatically a "member" of the PA – and those volunteering and elected to run the PA become charity "committee members"
- The committee is run by parental volunteers (who must have children at the school) to raise money to fund projects and purchase items to primarily enrich the children's educational experience at The Blue School
- Committee sign up to charity constitution and must adhere to certain rules
 - le. 1 x AGM (21 days notice) / 3 x committee meetings
 - We will upload our signed constitution to the school website



OUR GOALS

- To raise awareness of the role of the PA within the school community
- To engage and encourage parent participation from nursery to year 6
- To have a set of achievable fundraising goals short, medium, long term that benefit our children and the school
- To enhance relationships (between school, teachers, parents)

- As rep you are essentially signing up to be an extension of PA committee
 - To be the day-to-day link between PA team and classes (sharing our messages throughout the academic year, and being your class voice)
 - Additional comms / reminders / class support is up to the individual(s)
- Class events (ie. bake sales) rep is responsible for rallying troops / sign ups
- Full school events the PA ask all reps to help with planning, support and driving class participation please






