# WHAT IS THE PA?

- The PA is an independent registered charity with an elected committee who sign up to be trustees (usually for a two-year minimum term)
- Anyone with a child at The Blue School is automatically a “member” of the PA – and those volunteering and elected to run the PA become charity “committee members”
- The committee is run by parental volunteers (who must have children at the school) to raise money to fund projects and purchase items to primarily enrich the children’s educational experience at The Blue School
- Committee sign up to charity constitution and must adhere to certain rules
  - I.e. 1 x AGM (21 days notice) / 3 x committee meetings
  - We will upload our signed constitution to the school website



# OUR GOALS

- To raise awareness of the role of the PA within the school community
- To engage and encourage parent participation – from nursery to year 6
- To have a set of achievable fundraising goals – short, medium, long term that benefit our children and the school
- To enhance relationships (between school, teachers, parents)

# WHO WE ARE...

- As rep you are essentially signing up to be an extension of PA committee
  - To be the day-to-day link between PA team and classes (sharing our messages throughout the academic year, and being your class voice)
  - Additional comms / reminders / class support is up to the individual(s)
- Class events (ie. bake sales) – rep is responsible for rallying troops / sign ups
- Full school events – the PA ask all reps to help with planning, support and driving class participation please

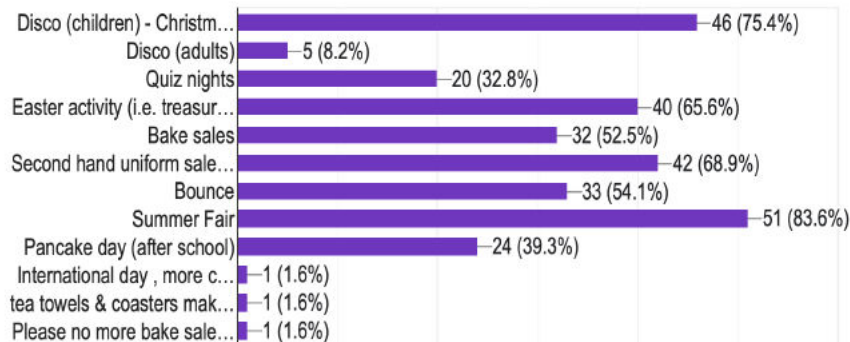

# PARENT FEEDBACK – PA ACTIVITY

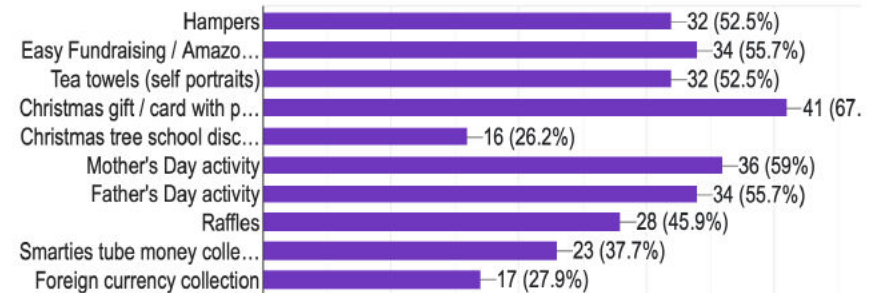
EVENTS: What events do you enjoy/ would you like to see happen again, that you would attend support?

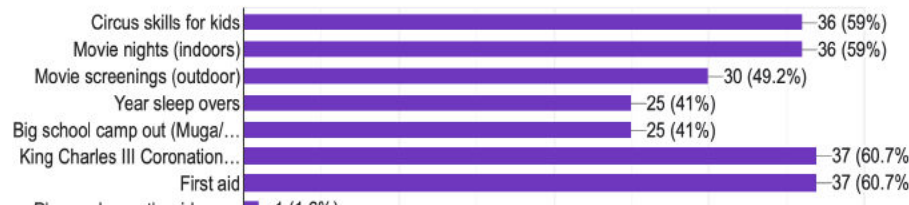
FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES: What activities are you happy to get involved with / support?

We can ask Ms Jones what other areas are being cut to balance the budget and where PA money could be best used.

I think this would honestly be best answered by staff at the school.

Notes re: areas PA can't invest. Feedback to be passed onto school.

(please do email or grab us to ask why these don't fall into PA remit)

My opinion : school may have to invest in online teaching app and testing tools like atom etc and fine tune the thinking skills. Secondly, please can some external sports event organising team conduct the sports days. I feel more professional sporting tutors and coaches would be beneficial for the school.

Over all these years, school day in my opinion is always no or less sports.

Could the PA fund more after school clubs?

The carpet in the common hallways should be replaced with a cleanable floor. The carpet can't be properly disinfected (specially after all the times that the bathroom gets flooded), looks really disgusting and it's a source of bacteria and mites. It gives an awful entrance to the Blue School.

We should ask the school! There's huge pressure at the moment with energy bills and staffing challenges. As a charity the PA might not be able to contribute to these core costs but we can ask Ms Jones what other areas are being cut to balance the budget and where PA money could be best used.

In natural plantbased products to clean the children living area rooms

Main hall flooring looked a bit worn too.

I can't remember if the school have one now but if not the purchase of a defibrillator.

It would be a good idea to have a general idea of what is the plan, as we have not been in the school long enough.

# MONEY OVERVIEW

- Opening balance of £18,605.21 at the start of the financial year beginning 1st of September 2022

- Outgoings amounted to £23,937.81\*\* which included donations to The Blue School of £15,863.55\*\*
- At the end of the financial year (31st August 2023) the PA held a closing cash balance of £22,699.18\*\*\*

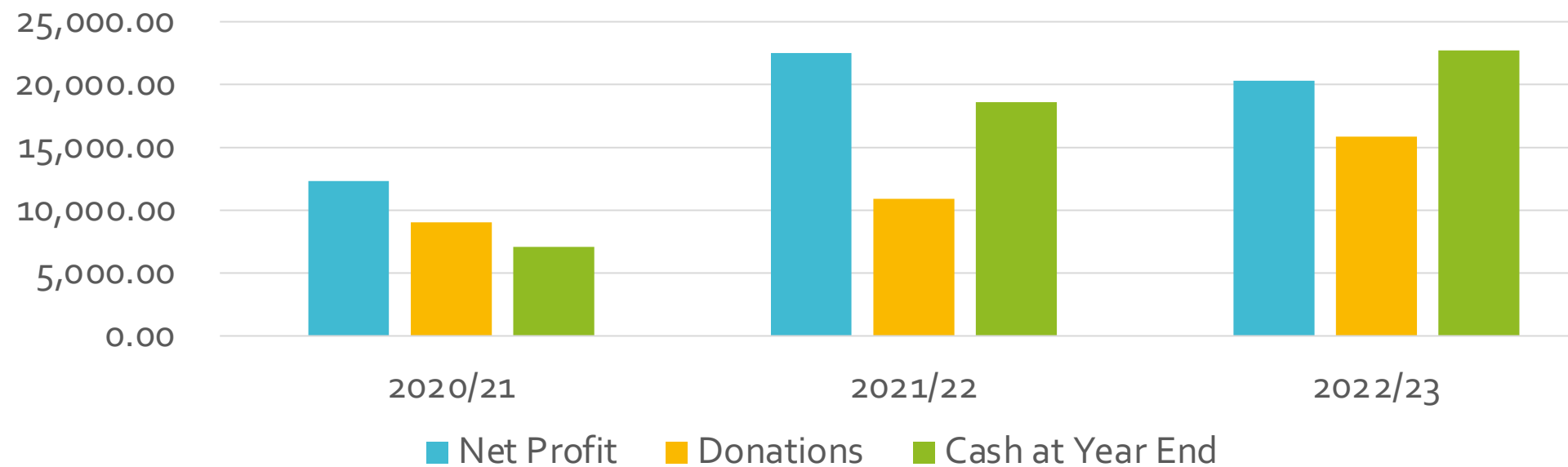

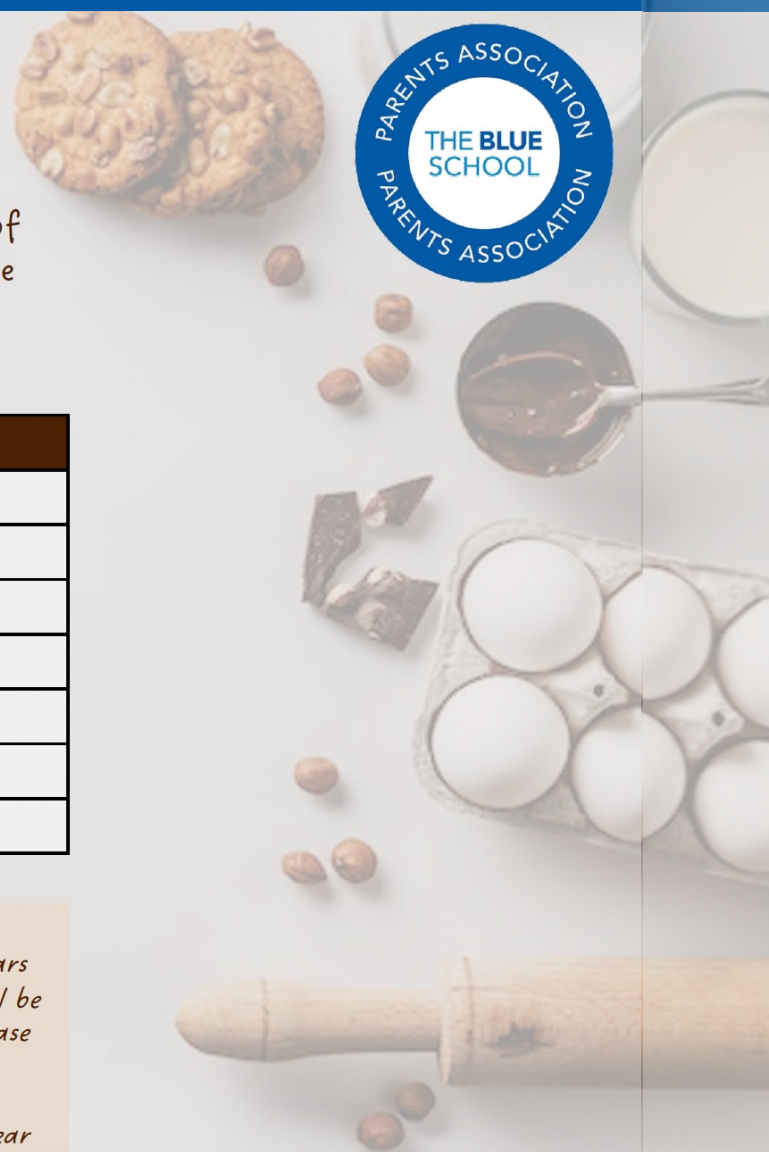
