

Y6 Worship Team Trip to St Paul's Cathedral

Last Thursday the Y6 Worship Team attended the London Diocesan

The theme was 'Agents of Reconciliation'. We were reminded about the parable of 'The Good Samaritan' (Luke 10: 25-37) in which Jesus encourages people to 'love your neighbour as yourself'. Pupils from

schools in London acted out the parable. Bishop Lusa introduced the 'World Reimagined globe' and discussed the beautiful design on it. The service was led by Bishop Sarah and guest speaker Dr Kris Kandiah. We were all given LED candles and held them high as Bishop Lusa led

us in prayer. We sang many hymns and enjoyed being part of this service (attended by 100 London schools). Eryk and George participated in the procession and were proud to carry our school banner.

The theme in Collective Worship this week is: God's Light (Shining as

light for God, recognising God's light in others) Psalm 112:1-9. We have been thinking about how we can be a light for others. For singing worship we revisited the hymn 'Living Lord'. The children sang beautifully!




